Date	Type of Experience or Activity

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The student reading list is a form you can use to list books your student is assigned to read and/or keep track of the books they have already read. The subject would designate class the title falls under such as science, history (with time period), geography, etc. If it is a book they read for leisure, that is, it wasn't an assigned book, they can list the book and put "leisure" in the subject line. The Category would list the kind of book such as illustrated classic, unabridged classic, historic fiction, biography, etc.

The student reading list is a form that you may use to list poems your student is assigned to read and/or keep track of the poems they have read. The type of poem is used to designate patterns, rhyme scheme, ballads, narrative, etc. The theme is a list of key words to designate the main theme of the poem such as love, grief, fear, faith, sympathy, commitment, etc.
